What is the LLVM Foundation?

- A 501(c)(3) public charitable organization
 - Founded in 2014
 - Public charities must serve the *public* good.
 - 11 person board, elected every two years
 - 2 employees

Mission

The LLVM Foundation's mission is to support education and advancement of the field of compilers and tools through educational events, grants and scholarships, increasing diversity within the field of compilers, tools, and the LLVM project, and directly supporting the LLVM Project community and infrastructure.

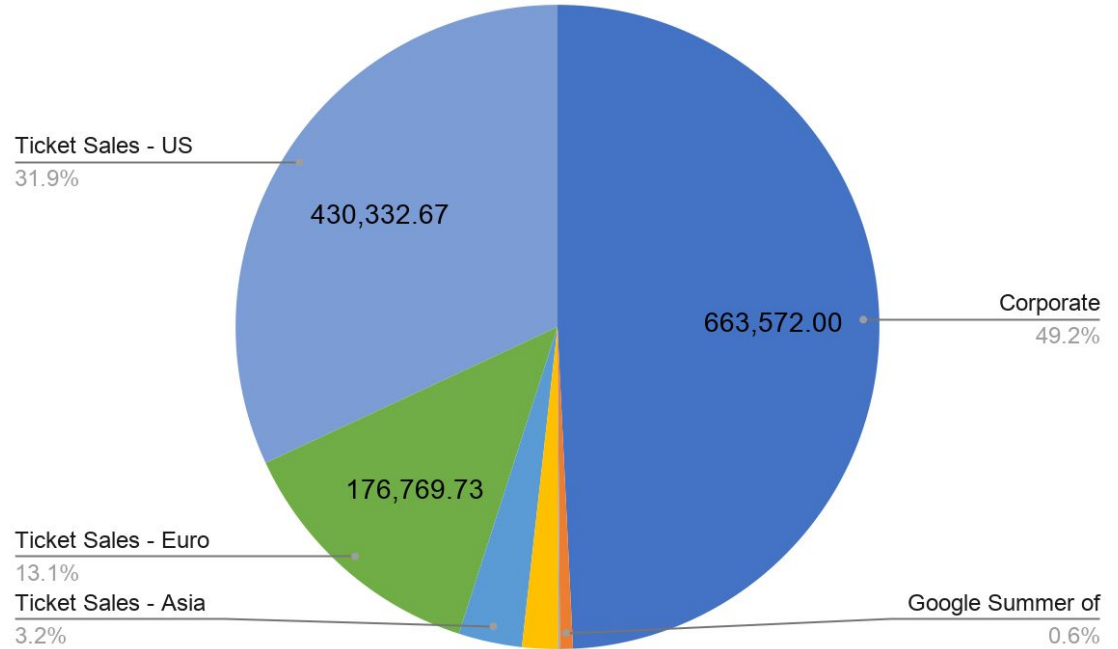
Joining the board

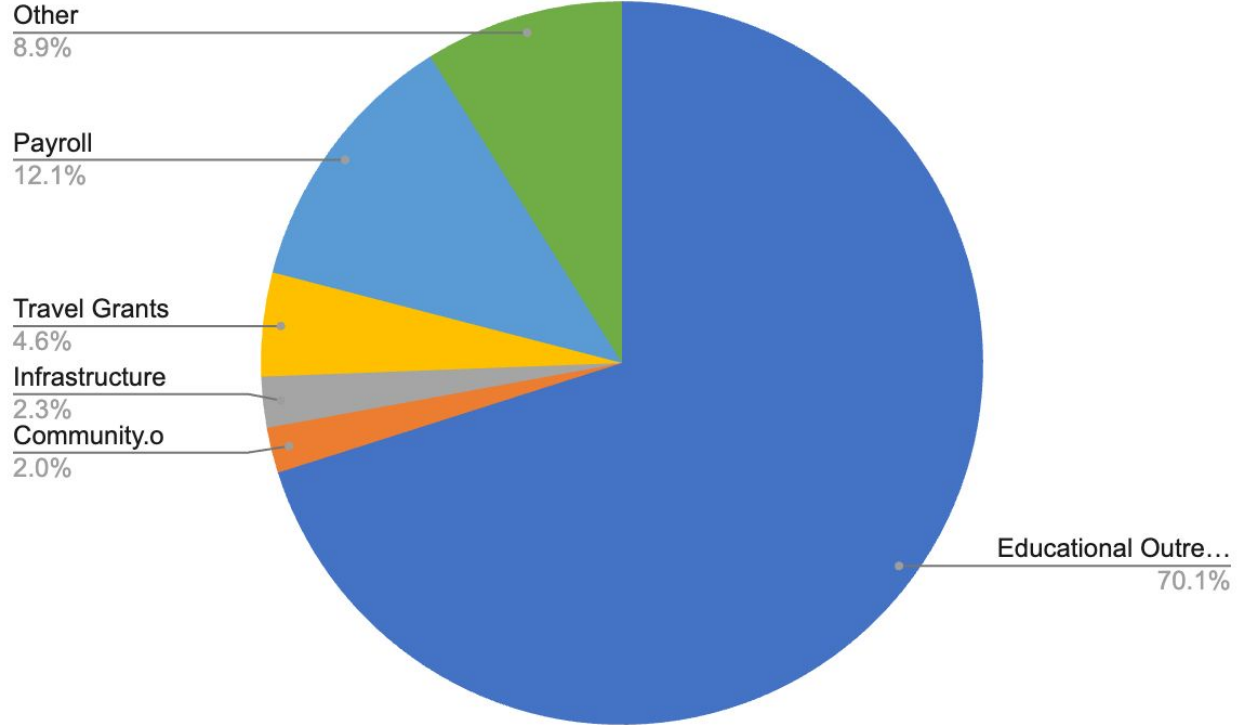

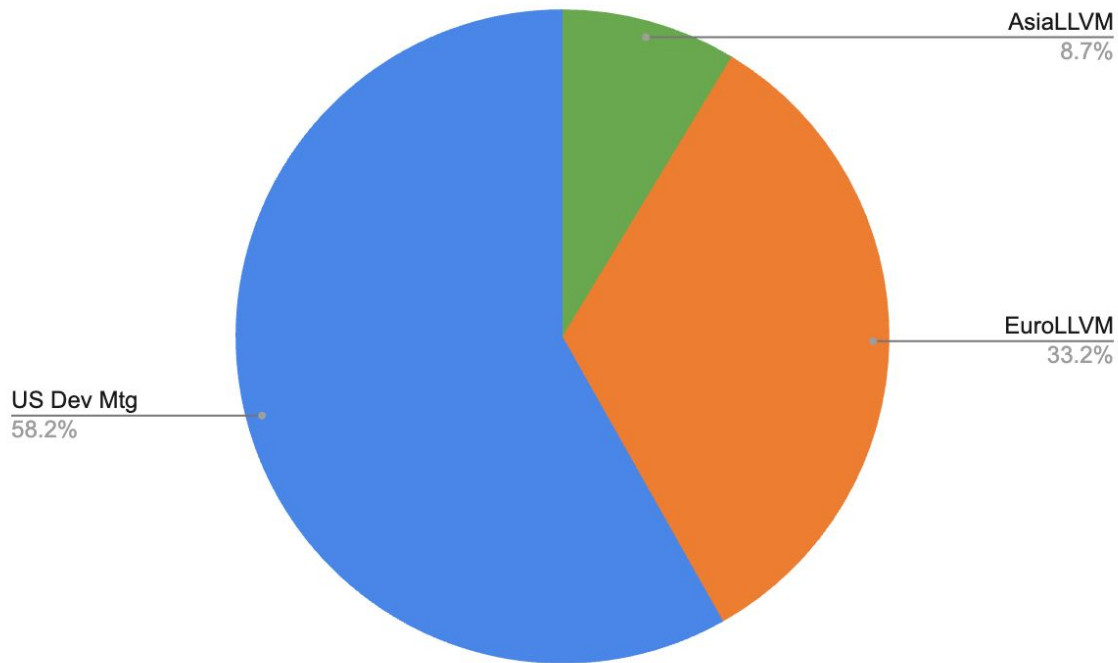

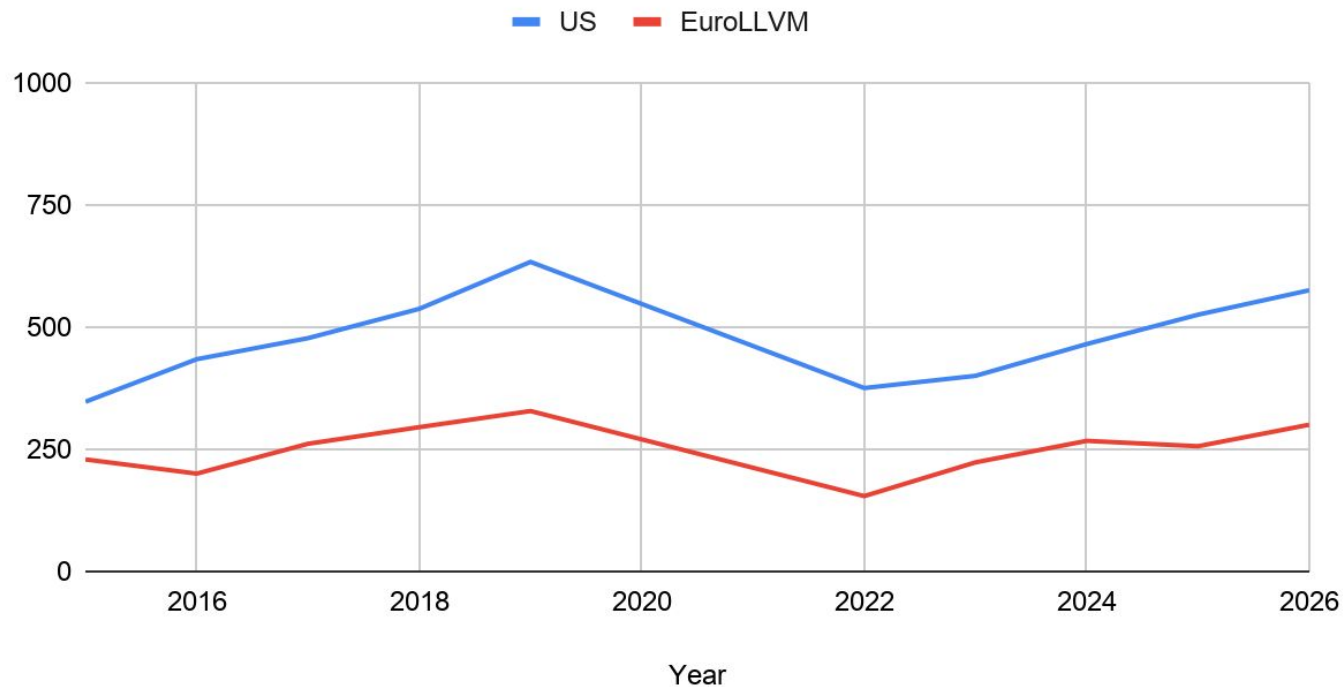

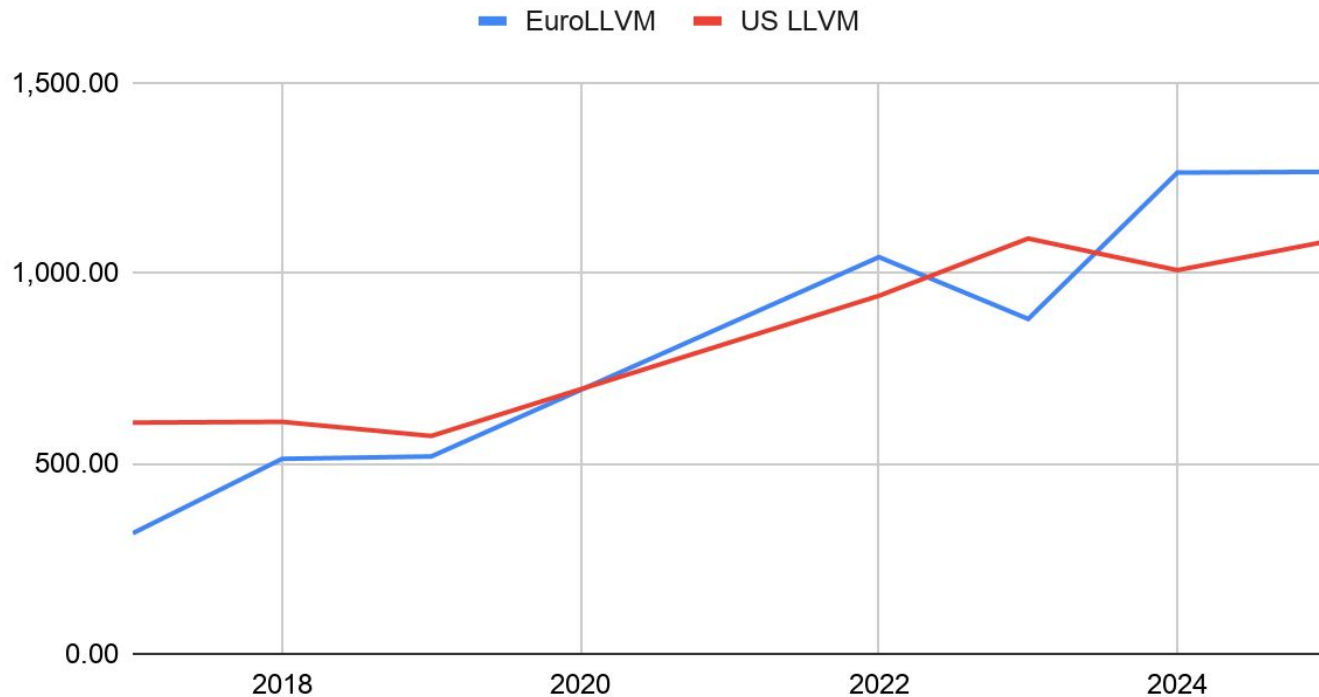
Dev Mtg Attendance Over the Years

US and EuroLLVM



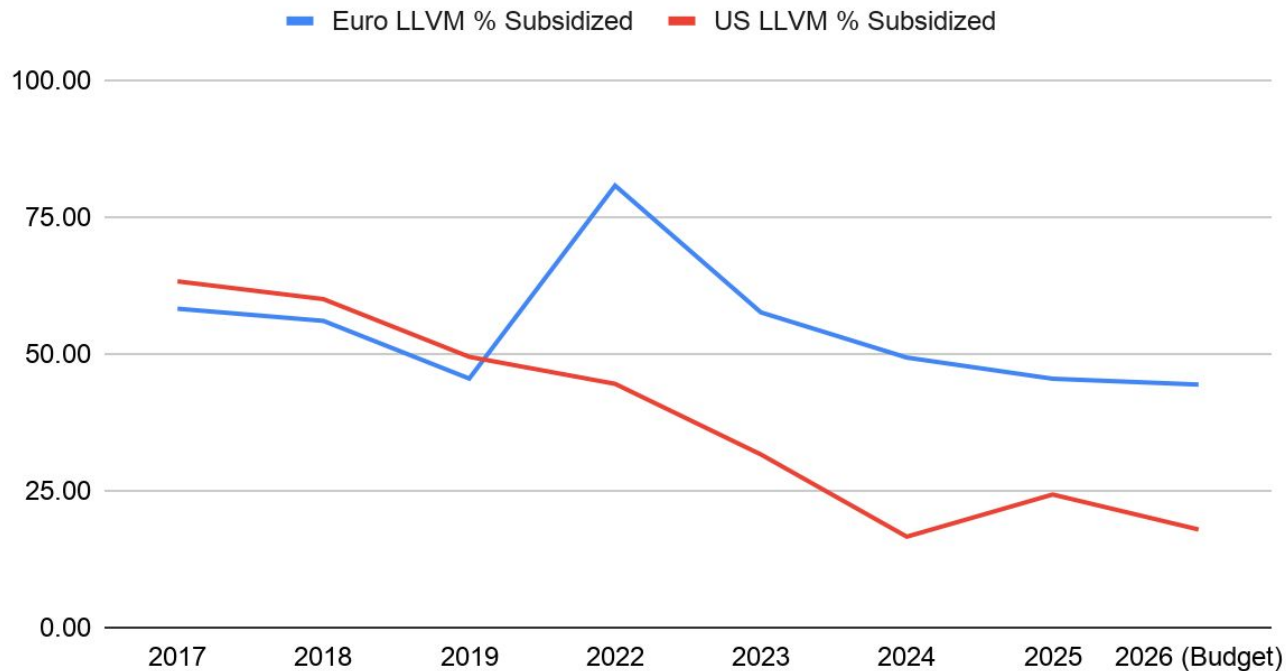
Dev Mtg Costs Per Person

Developer Meeting cost per person



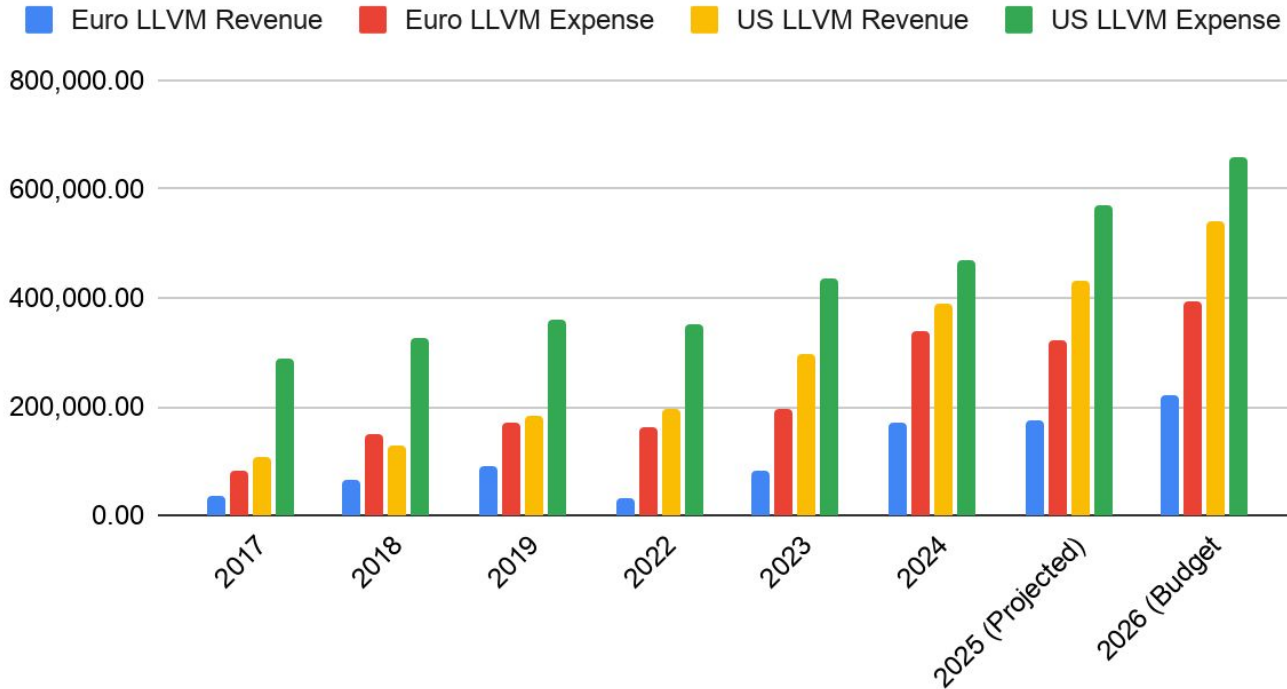
LLVM Dev Mtg - Ticket Subsidizes

Dev Mtg Revenue/Expenses

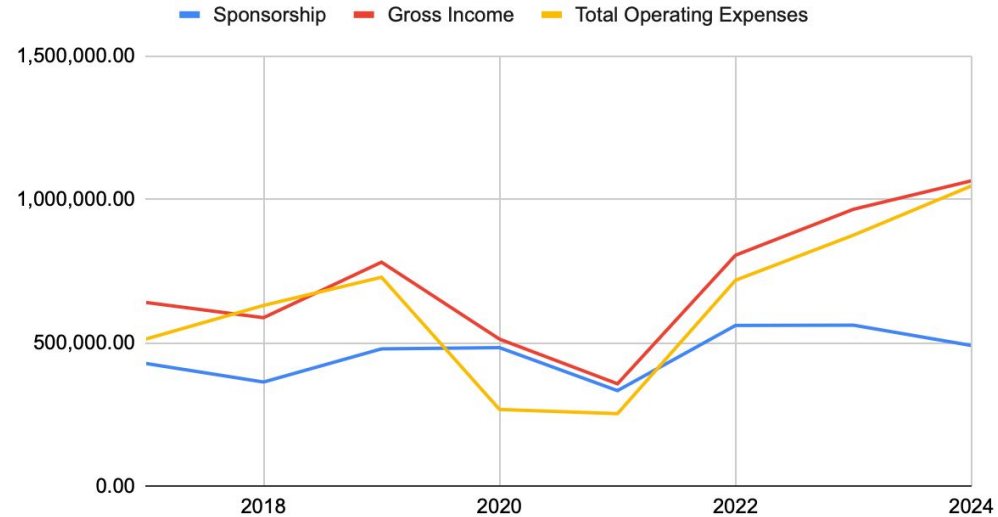
Dev Meeting revenue and expenses by year



Financials

- Sponsorship increased 14% from 2017 to 2024

\$200,000+

per year

◆ PLATINUM

\$100,000+

per year

Strong visibility with the LLVM developer community and increased conference presence.

◎ GOLD

Sliding Scale

\$10k – \$50k / year

Ideal for companies, startups, nonprofits, and academic institutions building LLVM ecosystem visibility.

1–499 employees: \$10k

500–2,999: \$25k

3,000+: \$50k
